Thank you to all who signed the handmade petition, 28 squares have been sent off to Open Doors.

The sale of cards last Sunday raised £57 for the ongoing work at the Trauma Centre in Nigeria.

The petition banner will be displayed at the Chapter House at Westminster Abbey with the portraits of the Nigerian women whose photos have been displayed in church. The women have produced self-portraits, many with tears of gold, which will also be on display. The petition will be available to view 17th-24th November and can be accessed without charge via the Cloisters.
